President's Message

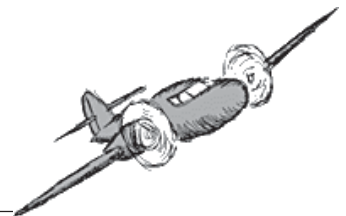

- Sunday May 21: Completion of Round Four. Score is based upon the average of best three flying rounds plus static score.

Entry Fee: \$30.00 per entry, Expert, Team Scale, Open, entry includes Saturday and Sunday lunch for Pilot and Caller.

Awards: Awards to third place (3) finishes in each class. Pilots Choice and Peoples Choice Award. Top 30% in each event (OPEN event must have a minimum score of 110) qualify for the Scale Masters.
