# HEMET MODEL MASTERS BOARD MEETING

Minutes for October 4, 2006

The meeting was called to order by President Turner at 7:00 PM

In attendance: All 4 Executive Members Present

In attendance: All 5 Board Members Present

In addition: 1 HMM member & 0 guests

President Turner opened the floor for discussion of "old" business.

The Christmas dinner date was affirmed to be December 9, 2006. The raffle prizes were discussed and agreed to as follows: 2- \$50.00 gift certificates for the ladies and a \$200 Radio and 3- \$100.00 gift certificates for the men. Harold Hodgerson is to contact and arrange for a performer (Jon Reuse 951.845.6248, cost \$100.00) for the party. His performance is to follow the dinner at 7:00 PM.
