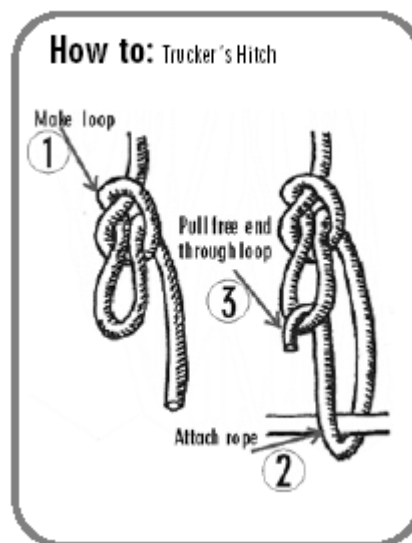

Trucker's Hitch

I used finishing line to make a
Kevlar braid, and then the braid as
a pull-pull rudder for my models. I
used it on a large biplane and had
good results, but on my triplane the
rudder was a little big and too
loose. When I flew my triplane, it
fishtailed in flight.

I spoke with a friend about my
problem, and I also mentioned that I
had trouble tightening the lines to get
the pull-pull system tight. John said
that I should use a Trucker's Hitch to
make the pull-pull system. It is
commonly used by fishermen to
cinch lines and make them secure.
Searching Trucker's Hitch on the
Internet will give you several
excellent explanations. In my *Ashley
Book of Knots*, I found a couple of
knots that might also work—they
are a Farmer's Loop, Harness Loop,
and Lineman's Loop. (The book
indicates that the Lineman's loop is
better than the Harness Loop. It is
stronger and easier to tie).
All of these knots create a bight
in the line where you can make a
loop for cinching the line tight.
They are all finished with halfhitches
to keep them from slipping.
Of course, finish the job with a dab
of super-glue to make sure it never
gets untied or slips.

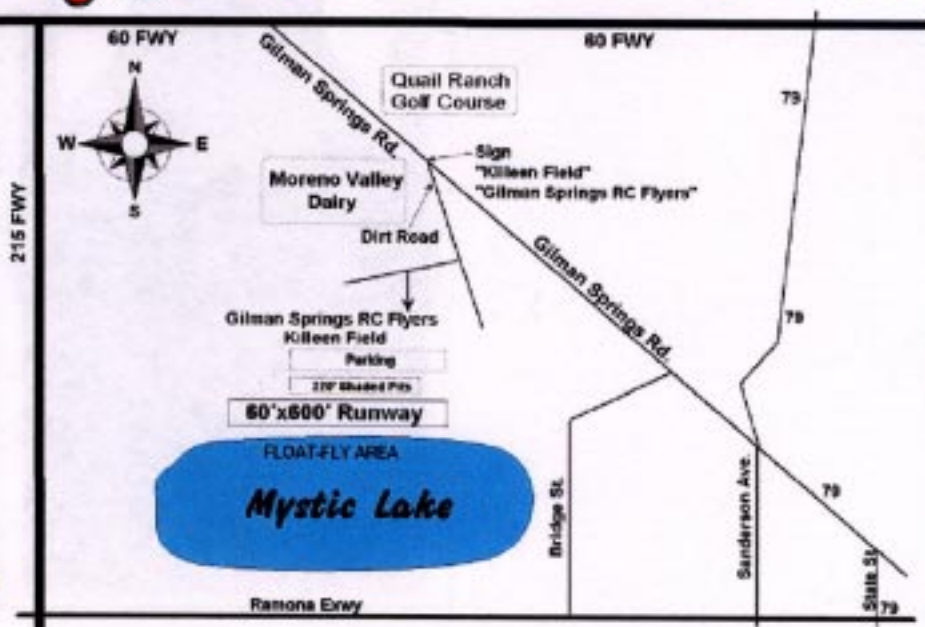
